Bishop Charlene Kammerer. She obtained her Master of Christian Education and MDiv degrees from Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary and was ordained an elder in 1977 in the Florida Conference. She received a DMin in 1991 from United Theological Seminary in Dayton, Ohio.

Her service has been in parish and connec-tional ministries, including campus minister at Duke University, District Superintendent in the Tallahassee District, Director of the General Commission on the Status and Role of Women, Director of the General Board of Global Ministries, including chair of the UMC Committee on Relief from 1992-1996.

Elected to the episcopacy at the South Eastern Jurisdictional (SEJ) Conference in 1996, she was assigned to the Charlotte Area where she served faithfully for eight years and, in 2004, she was assigned to the Vir-ginia Conference.

Rev. Shane Benjamin, MDiv, Duke Divinity School. He is an Elder in the North Carolina Conference of the United Methodist Church and currently serves in his 11th year as pas-tor of Asbury Temple UMC in Durham. He also assists with classes related to ministry and pastoral care at Duke Divinity School

Rev. Bill Braswell, AB and MAT from UNC-Chapel Hill, MDiv from Duke Divinity School, An Elder, he has served as a pastor in the NC Conference for over 30 years and is currently pastor of Pine Valley UMC in Wilmington.

Patrice Cheasty-Miller An Elder in the NC Conference, she is pastor of Sanctuary UMC, a missional reconciling church in Durham. She has a long history of justice ministries through the Durham District Mission Society, Clergy Women, and hosting local AA groups. She is founder of The Lamb's Coffee House.

Rev. Christopher Kudzai Chikoore, a native of Zimbabwe, is pastor of Shepherd's House UMC, a new church start in Durham. Ordained an Elder in the UMC Zimbabwe conference in 1985, he served rural and urban churches, as student chaplain, Conference Council on Minis-tries Director, and DS of the Harare East Dis-trict. In 2000 he served in Lakeland Fl before moving to the NC Conference in 2003.

Rev. Gayle Felton. MDiv and PhD, Duke Uni-versity. She has served on faculties of Mere-dith College and Duke Divinity School and was the principal author of the United Methodist official statements on the sacraments. Gayle serves as Minister of Christian Formation at Calvary UMC in Durham and as adjunct faculty at Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary.

Rev. Bill Jeffries Bill was a pastor from 1956-1999, except for an 11-year period, 1964-75, when he was Peace Education Direc-tor of the American Friends Service Committee for Southeastern States. Much of his empha-sis in ministry has been in peace and human relations, and in retirement is active in the Friends Committee on National Legislation.

Rev. Rosana Panizo An Elder in the NC Conference, she is a native of Peru where she once served as rector of the Methodist Semi-nary. Following her tenure as a pastor, she now serves the Durham District as a missionary with the General Board of Global Ministries.

Dr. Mark Wethington, MDiv and PhD, Duke University. He served as pastor in NC for 27 years and adjunct faculty at Duke Divinity School for 15 yrs. He has been president of the Wesley Heritage Foundation since 2005, as well as, founder and director of a free medical clinic in Moore Co., NC.

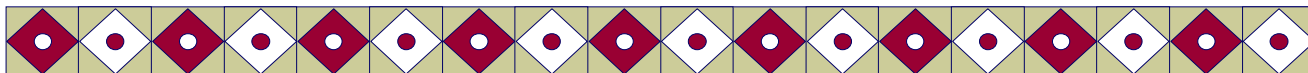

The Jack Crum Legacy

Dr. Jack Crum (1926-2008) received his MDiv from Duke University and his DMin from Boston University. He served as a United Methodist minister of the NC Conference for 37 years from 1953-1989, beginning with his appointment as pastor of Avent Ferry UMC for 4 years. He served as director of Christian Social Action for the N.C. Council of Churches from 1964-69. Dr. Crum was given the award for Distinguished Service on the Care of Ecumenical Christianity from N.C. Council of Churches in 1997. He created the Endowment for a Prophetic Church in 1990 to aid churches in becoming active in social advocacy ad action. Dr. Crum established a Scholarship Endowment Fund for Prophetic Ministries with Duke University Divinity School in 2000 to assist the education of students for an informed Christian activism that confronts both system and prejudices for constructive change.

For over 100 years, the **Methodist Federation for Social Action** has been a powerful movement committed to the transformation of the church and society by working on **Peace, Poverty, and Peoples' Rights**. The MFSA wrote the first **Social Creed** of the then Methodist Episcopal Church (1908). A revised Creed and Litany was approved in 2008.
